Interaction between participants and resource persons will take place in the last half hour of each session. Participants are encouraged to make optimum use of the workshop.

PROFILE OF THE NEW SPORTS

HANDBALL (also known as team handball, field-ball, European handball or Olympic handball) is a team sport in which two teams of seven players each (six outfield players and a goalkeeper) pass a ball using their hands with the aim of throwing it into the goal of the other team.

A standard match consists of two periods of 30 minutes, and the team that scores the most goals wins. The game is fast and high-scoring: professional teams now typically score between 20 and 35 goals each, though lower scores were not uncommon until a few decades ago. Body contact is permitted, the defenders trying to stop the attackers from approaching the goal.

NETBALL is similar to basketball although the rules, equipment and team numbers are different. The game is very simple yet very fast paced. This is the only game where in no body contact is allowed: 7 players for a team. There is no dribbling, a player cannot run with the ball; 7 ball passed within 3 seconds; ball & basket slightly smaller; no backboard; players designated to certain areas. Netball has the following advantages: true team sport, great game to improve hand/eye coordination and teaches spacial awareness.

The objective of a game is to score more goals than the opposition. Goals are scored when a team member positioned in the attacking shooting circle shoots the ball through the goal ring.

AEROBICS is a form of physical exercise that combines rhythmic aerobic exercise with stretching and strength training routines with the goal of improving elements of fitness (flexibility, muscular strength, and cardio-vascular fitness). It is usually performed to music and may be practiced in a group setting led by an instructor (fitness professional), although it can be done solo and without musical accompaniment. With the goal of preventing illness and promoting physical fitness, practitioners perform various routines comprising a number of different dance-like exercises. Formal aerobics classes are divided into different levels of intensity and complexity. A well-balanced aerobics class will have five components: warm-up (5-10 minutes), cardio vascular conditioning (25-30 minutes), muscular strength and conditioning (10-15 minutes), cool-down (5-8 minutes) and stretching and flexibility (5-8 minutes). Aerobics classes may allow participants to select their level of participation according to their fitness level. Many gyms offer a variety of aerobic classes. Each class is designed for a certain level of experience and taught by a certified instructor with a specialty area related to their particular class.
