**Article 2:**

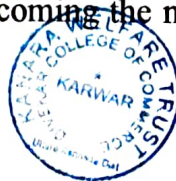
PAHARE VEDIKE, Karwar shall organize various workshops and seminars for the students of D.C.C., Karwar.


