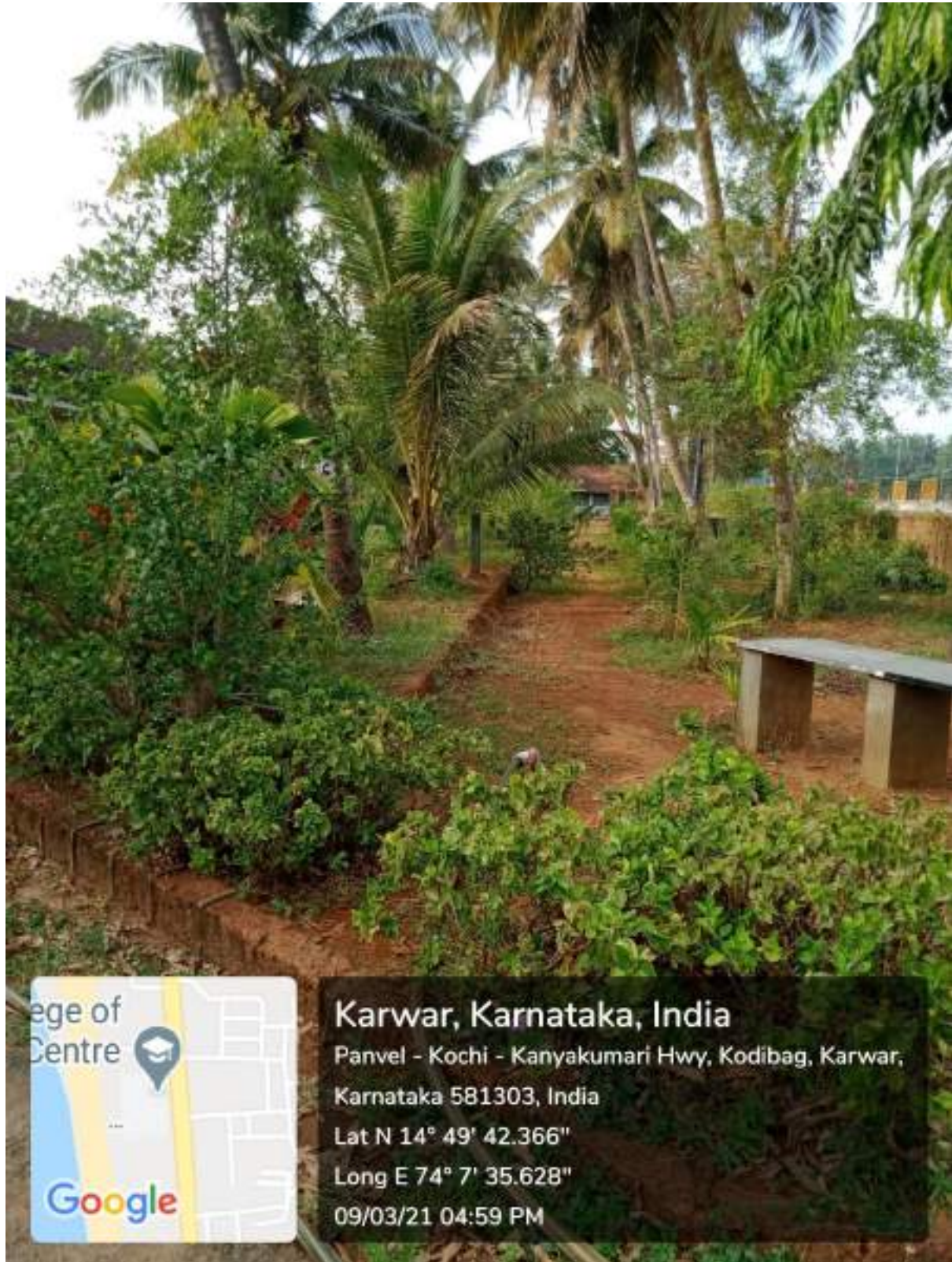

GREEN AUDIT

The Uttara Kannada Jilla Vijnana Kendra established in the year 2003 has been actively involved in creating scientific temperament among people and providing scientific input to the institutions in the district. One of the most important activity has been assisting the Karnataka Pollution Control Board in providing awareness and guiding them in the needy times. Also we have been assisting the district administration on issues related to environment. Our members are drawn from various fields of science and environment experts from Universities, Colleges and officials retired after prolonged service in different departments, both central and state.

Divekar College of Commerce located west of National Highway on the sea shore has been catering for the needs of the students for nearly five decades. The institution was established by the great educationist and poet commonly called as 'Chutuku Bramha' Shree Dinakar Desai, a person who was known for educating the rural needy and one of the specialty of the Institutes established by him is huge premises that caters for the overall development of the children with a healthy environment.

The science center has been associated with the College ever since we established the center and have been organizing various activities in the college that include a state level seminar, environment day, Ocean day, Water day etc. We prefer this institution for our activities to showcase the environment friendly Institution for others to follow suit.

As a part of our activity our team of experts visited the College to survey the green credits to prevent carbon footprints. Our observations are as under.

1. **Air flow management:** The building is constructed in such a way that there is scope for free flow of air into almost all the class rooms that artificial electric appliances such as fans, coolers and AC are not required in the rooms. Though

Report of the expert committee to examine the environment status of Divekar College of Commerce Karwar

The team of experts of Uttara Kannada Jilla Vijnana Kendra Karwar visited the Divekar College of Commerce on 5.05.20 and inspected the environment management and green audit in the campus. Following is the brief report:

1. **Light** : The entire premises and the campus is well lit and there is no need of artificial/electric light during the college hours. Thus energy wastage for providing light is minimum to nil. Only during extraordinary circumstances of heavy rains and clouds lights are used.
2. **Air flow**: Broad window and large doors cater for the wind flow in view of their west-east direction. Therefore though fans are fitted for extra-ordinary circumstances they are not used in normal circumstances. Thus energy is saved.
3. **Sanitation**: The institution is equipped with good toilets separately for ladies and gents thus a clean campus is maintained.
4. **Solid waste management**: The entire campus is maintained plastic free and provisions are made to collect the biodegradable solid waste in the form of pits. The plastic waste is segregated and sent to municipality.
5. **Biodiversity and greenery**: The institution is well aware of the importance of regional biodiversity and has planted the local varieties of plants with most dominant coconut trees. Beautiful garden is maintained. Large number of birds and other animals can be seen in the campus.
6. **Soil conservation**: In order to prevent soil erosion the ground grass and vegetation is regularly trimmed and maintained.

It can be concluded from the inspection that the College has been looking after the environmental issues with great concern and can be called as a Green Institution.

Green Audit

Team of Experts form Uttara Kannada Jilla Vijnana Kendra, Karwar (R) visited the Divekar College of Commerce, Karwar on 25.04.2021 to examine the scope for environment management in the campus. The summary of the expert committee opinion is listed below.

- 1. Overall Campus :** The campus has a compound wall to prevent flow of unwanted people and animals. A beautiful garden is maintained. The entire campus has different types of plants planted and well maintained. All of them are 30-40 years old and attribute to local themes that can harbor biodiversity. Major part of the construction is local with tiled roof to sustain the heavy wind, rains common in the coastal area. The buildings are scientifically designed to motivate students to study. The western side of the campus is on the sea shore and the eastern boundary is very close to the National Highway.
- 2. Light:** The buildings area designed in such a way that all the rooms are well lit by the sun light during day time. Thus no electricity is required during class hours and thus help save energy. However provisions are made for extreme situation during rainy days.
- 3. Air flow:** The windows are broad and the halls have parallel windows west to eastwards so that there is regular wind flow. Though fans are fixed in the class rooms they are generally not used during class hours thus saving on electricity.
- 4. Water:** Though water is available in adequate quantity, the water management has been a priority to educate the students. Regular awareness programmes are organized to provide awareness. Students are aware of the global and local scenario.
- 5. Waste management:** The entire campus is made plastic free. Solid waste is collected in the bins and disposed in the pits. The entire campus is free from the solid waste.
- 6. Green credits:** The Institution has large number of trees and green floor catering for the oxygen demand.
